1. Meeting Called to Order

Board Chair Bellotti called the meeting to order at 9:06 A.M.

2. Discussion and potential vote on vendor RFQs

- → Information Technology (IT) Vendor RFQ The Board received quotes from two vendors, Wizard and Harbor Network. The Board reviewed the quotes and Executive Director Keily-Becchetti gave an overview of both proposals. On a motion by Paul Connors and seconded by Edwin Little, the Board unanimously voted, in a roll-call vote, 3-0, to move forward with Harbor Network.
 - Josephine Shea asked for the initial vote to be reconsidered as she was not present for that vote. On a motion by Paul Connors and seconded by Edwin Little, the Board unanimously voted, in a roll-call vote, 4-0, to reconsider the previous vote and move forward with Harbor Network.
- → Office Furniture Vendor RFQ The Board received quotes from WB Mason and Creative Office Resources. The Board reviewed the quotes and Executive Director Keily-Becchetti gave an overview of both proposals. On a motion by Paul Connors and seconded by Edwin Little, the Board unanimously voted, in a roll-call vote, 4-0, to move forward with Creative Officer Resources.

Pertaining to the MHTL May of 2024 legal services invoice, Executive Director Keily-Becchetti and Compliance Officer Feeney informed the Board of some concerns that they had raised with MHTL. In response, MHTL offered a 5% discount that the Board accepted.
